Godby Student Arrested with Firearm on Campus

A Leon County School Resource Deputy arrested Jahill Butts 14, for Possession of a Firearm on School Property.

This morning, Godby High School staff was conducting an inquiry regarding stolen ear phones. In an effort to locate the ear phones they conducted an administrative search of Butts' backpack. During this search school staff found an unloaded firearm and one round of ammunition. School staff followed protocol, immediately notified the School Resource Deputy and turned the firearm over to him.

Butts was taken into custody without incident. The investigation is continuing to determine how and where Butts obtained the firearm.

"One of our primary goals at the Leon County Sheriff's Office is the safety of our children especially in our schools. We will not tolerate students carrying weapons on our campuses," stated Sheriff Walt McNeil.
