LCSO S.P.I.D.E.R. Unit Nabs Four in Stolen Vehicle Investigation

On March 25, 2020, a victim contacted LCSO to report the theft of a 2004 green Toyota Tundra truck from a residence.

On the same date, the LCSO S.P.I.D.E.R. (Special Projects Investigations Detection Enforcement Response) Unit was on patrol in the area of the 1600 block of West Tennessee Street when they observed the stolen Toyota truck traveling eastbound from Caliark Street. Deputies attempted a traffic stop and the driver, 17-year-old Asantae Hall, fled northbound on Basin Street. A Florida Highway Patrol Trooper, who was in the area, initiated a pursuit, while the LCSO Aviation Unit surveilled the vehicle from above. The vehicle ultimately ran into a ditch at the intersection of Colorado Street and Greentree Court. Hall bailed from the truck and began running behind other residences on Colorado Street. FHP deployed a K9 and Hall was apprehended.

A 17-year-old male, 14-year-old male and 14-year-old Jymarries Fedd were located inside the stolen vehicle. The investigation determined Fedd and Hall were to be wearing ankle monitors. During the investigation, Fedd made physical threats to a deputy on scene, was found to be in possession of brass knuckles, and admitted to cutting off his ankle monitor. Through investigative means, Fedd was found to have multiple outstanding felony warrants.

The unnamed juveniles were charged with misdemeanors.

All four subjects were arrested and transported to the Juvenile Assessment Center.
