LCSO Arrests Student for Written Threats, Prioritizing School Safety

On Monday, March 3, the Leon County Sheriff's Office received a tip regarding a student at Godby High School who allegedly made threats of a bombing to the school on a Twitter post. The student, a 14-year-old female, was interviewed about the social media post and admitted to making the threat because she did not want to be at school.

The student is charged with felony written threats to kill, do bodily injury, or conduct a mass shooting or an act of terrorism and was transported to the Juvenile Assessment Center.

LCSO, in coordination with Leon County Schools, treats all threats toward schools with the highest level of concern. We remain committed to investigating any potential threats and ensuring the safety of students and staff. Parents and guardians are encouraged to discuss the gravity of making threats with their children and the potential legal consequences.
