LCSO Investigating Fatal Traffic Crash

This morning, just before 7 A.M., Leon County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a traffic crash involving two vehicles in the 6300 block of Blountstown Highway. Upon arrival, deputies and firefighters with the Tallahassee Fire Department located a blue Honda Civic passenger car with extensive rear-end damage and Dodge Ram truck with front-end damage, indicating a rear-end collision.

Emergency medical treatment was provided to both drivers on scene. The driver of the Honda was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The driver of the Dodge truck was medically released at the scene.

Life saving measures were attempted on the passenger of the Honda, however the passenger was pronounced dead on scene.

The LCSO Traffic Homicide Unit was called in to assume the investigation.

This investigation is still open and active. In accordance with Marsy's Law, the deceased's information has been withheld by family request.
